## School Dress Code

### **Rationale**

In our daily lives we all vary our speech, dress and general deportment according to the situation. People show courtesy and respect to other people and occasions by choosing to behave in certain ways. An important life skill for children to learn is to be observant of other's behaviour (and body language) and to modify and adapt where appropriate. As part of this learning, we expect children to proudly wear their school uniform when:-

- Attending school
- Going on excursions
- Representing the school at special occasions

### **Modification to Dress Code**

Parents of students who for religious or health reasons may need to modify the school dress code are required to make an appointment with the Principal. Staff will be informed of any student granted a modification to the dress code.

Students not following the dress code will receive:-

- Counselling from class teachers on the benefits of a dress code
- Assistance/support to obtain suitable clothing if necessary

Students not following the dress code may be denied the opportunity to represent their school as this may be a safety issue. Students are not permitted to wear offensive or unsafe clothing. This can be enforced under the Education Act.





Parents who have financial difficulties regarding the purchase of a uniform should contact the principal to discuss the situation. Second-hand uniforms may be available. Donations of second-hand uniforms in good condition are greatly appreciated.

<b>Footwear</b> 	From a health and safety aspect, the correct footwear is important due to the number of hours and the activities that children are involved in. <b>Hats</b> 	Navy sun smart hat with school logo – broad all around brim or with flap on back. No caps. Our school implements a Sunsmart policy where hats must be worn for all outdoor activities - “No hat - No play”. (Please refer to policy).
