**Information for Parents and Carers**  
**Term 2 – Week 1 & 2**

- Monday 27 April:** Anzac Day Public Holiday
- Tuesday 28 April:**
  - This is a pupil free day. Students do not attend school;
  - Parents are able to collect remote learning packages for Week 1 & 2 from the school using the following timetable for collection;
  - Only one person from each family should collect packages;
  - Please adhere to social distancing rules and there will be no face-to-face meetings;
  - These packages have been developed collaboratively by your child's classroom teacher and are the same program that students will follow if they attend school in Week 1 & 2;
  - Please do not pick up the remote learning package if you intend on sending your child to school in Week 1 & 2.

- Wednesday 29 April:**
  - Schools are open for all parents and carers who choose to send their children;
  - Students who attend school will complete the same learning program developed by your child's classroom teacher as those learning from home through the remote learning package;
  - For students learning at home, additional resources are available on the [Department of Education](#) website or the [Duncraig PS](#) website;
  - For those students learning from home, contact by the school will be made each week by phone and/or on-line and feedback given on work package completion where possible;
  - Parents and carers of children and young people with complex medical needs are encouraged to seek medical advice regarding attendance at school.

4. **With regard to safety, DPS will implement the following:**
- Alternative arrangements as required for vulnerable employees as defined by the Department of Health;
  - Increased environmental cleaning throughout the day, including high touch surfaces;
  - Hygiene measures including handwashing schedule and use of sanitiser;
  - Some school play areas will be open and cleaned;
  - Excursions, assemblies, camps and interschool activities will not be conducted;
  - Encouraging students to maintain 1.5m physical distancing;
  - Moving desks wider apart, where possible;
  - Group activities suspended if the activity cannot be modified to avoid close proximity;
  - Utilise alternative teaching environments with increased ventilation and greater space for social distancing to occur;
  - Staff encouraged to use block kitchenettes for breaks;
  - All external doors will remain open to minimise touching;
  - Canteen will be closed for the first 3 weeks of term. Information regarding reopening of services will be provided when available.
5. Advice for schools from WA Government is that parents and carers should not enter school grounds for student drop off and pick up.
- Kindy students to be dropped off and picked up from the kindy gate;
  - Students may use any entry point to the school;
  - If you require supervised drop off or pick up, please use the Currajong Road entry between 8:30 and 8:50am where your child will be taken to the undercover area or classroom by a staff member;
  - Be mindful of local traffic and parking rules apply.
6. More information will be released regarding Week 3 & 4 by 6 May. The government will review arrangements for schools in the lead up to Week 4 and any adjustments will be made based on health advice and infection trends across the community.
7. If your child is sick, they must not come to school. You must keep them at home and away from others.
